This internship will support the ICLA Global Team in strengthening KOBLI's digital outreach, advertising and online engagement.

Requirements

- Currently enrolled in a degree programme in IT, Digital Marketing, Communications or a comparable field.
- Initial practical or theoretical experience in digital marketing, communications, social media or a related field is desirable.
- Familiarity with humanitarian work is desirable.
- Strong analytical, organisational and written communication skills.
- Fluency in German and English, both written and spoken.
- Strong teamwork and communication skills, high motivation, and the ability to quickly and independently familiarise yourself with new topics.
