2. Onboard laptops (Windows/macOS) into MDM; arrange occasional hand-overs in the Berlin office.
3. Triage first-line tickets (password resets, access issues) and escalate complex cases.
4. Run weekly maintenance: check patch status, backup logs, security-centre alerts.
5. Document fixes & run-books so the next person (maybe you, maybe future-you) can repeat them fast.

Stretch projects (≈ 20 % time):

1. Research current CVEs affecting SaaS stacks and brief the team,
2. Script a “one-click hardening” setup for new laptops,
3. Help draft our incident-response playbook or ISO 27001 checklist.
