- Interest in climate policy, the decarbonisation of industries, relevant macroeconomic effects and structural change;
- Initial work experience (e.g. in the context of internships) is an advantage;
- Ability to communicate complex issues clearly and in a manner appropriate to the

target group;

- Confident handling of qualitative and quantitative data;
- Strong problem-solving skills and attention to detail;
- Confident user knowledge of MS Office products such as Excel, PowerPoint and Word;
- For a quantitative focus, programming skills, e.g. in Python, are a plus;
- Very good English and German language skills;
- A high degree of initiative and motivation, very good communication and teamwork skills, and interest in working in inter- and transdisciplinary groups.
