Your profile:

 o special aptitude for academic work, usually demonstrated by the quality of a doctoral degree,
 o additional academic achievements, e.g. a positively evaluated junior professorship, habilitation, or equivalent
 qualifications,
- o teaching aptitude, demonstrated through your teaching portfolio (see https://www.tu.berlin/go209650/).
- In-depth academic knowledge in the field of Logistics in at least two of the above-mentioned research fields, evidenced by publications or third-party funded research projects, is essential.
- · Recognized expertise and experience from research and teaching in the area of Logistics is required.
- As an internationally oriented university, we expect the ability to teach in both German and English, or the willingness to acquire the necessary language skills within a reasonable timeframe.
- Several years of professional experience, preferably in leadership roles with an international orientation, are desirable.
- Experience in leading and/or contributing to basic research projects and research networks in the subject area is advantageous, as is
- · experience in promoting junior researchers and in knowledge and technology transfer.
- Gender and diversity competences complete your profile.
