The Karottine project aims to promote more sustainable nutrition in communal catering by increasing the percentage of plant-based products in the menu. In cooperation with Münster University of Applied Sciences, the Fördergemeinschaft Ökologischer Landbau (FÖL) (Association for the Promotion of Organic Agriculture), organic processing companies as well as canteens and caterers, the project aims to strengthen the nutritional and preparation skills of communal catering in Berlin-Brandenburg, support more sustainable consumption and eating habits among consumers, and promote cooperation along the value chain.
