

## Weizenbaum-Institut e.V.



Das 2017 gegründete Weizenbaum-Institut erforscht die Auswirkungen der fortschreitenden Digitalisierung auf unsere Gesellschaft. Es trägt mit seinen Handlungsempfehlungen dazu bei, dass die digitale Transformation nachhaltig, selbstbestimmt und verantwortungsvoll gestaltet wird. Das Weizenbaum-Institut wird von einem Verbund aus sieben Partnern getragen, dem die Freie Universität Berlin, die Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin, die Technische Universität Berlin, die Universität der Künste Berlin, die Universität Potsdam, das Fraunhofer-Institut für Offene Kommunikationssysteme (FOKUS) und das Wissenschaftszentrum Berlin für Sozialforschung (WZB) angehören. Work content The interdisciplinary research group "Digitalization and Opening up Science" (<https://www.weizenbaum-institut.de/en/research/organizing-knowledge/digitalization-and-opening-up-science/>) is concerned with the scientific practices surrounding the development, evaluation and use of artificial intelligence (AI), in short "AI as a science" and "science with AI". It analyzes and evaluates the epistemic and ethical aspects of AI research and develops standards and approaches to improve its practices, in particular data practices and infrastructures.
