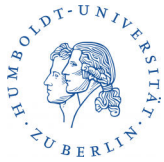


## **Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin - The School of Business and Economics**

### **Tasks**

We are looking for an economist with a proven track-record and publications in leading international journals, as well as an excellent international research network. The successful candidate should conduct policy-relevant and cutting-edge empirical or theoretical research with a strong focus on international economics broadly defined, including fields such as international trade, international finance, macroeconomics, geoeconomics and security. The candidate should become a faculty member of the Berlin School of Economics. Ideally, the candidate has interest and experience in leading a research group and translating research into policy advice, as well as experience in acquiring third-party funding. In the area of teaching, the appointee will contribute 2 LVS to one of the faculty's study programs.

### **Requirements**

The applicants must meet the legal requirements for professorial appointments in accordance with § 100 of the `Berliner Hochschulgesetz`.

### **Application**

Humboldt-Universität and the Kiel Institute are seeking to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching, and specifically encourage qualified female scholars to apply. Researchers from abroad are welcome to apply. Severely disabled applicants with equivalent qualifications will be given preferential consideration. People with an immigration history are specifically encouraged to apply.

- (4) a research concept describing the candidate's current research program and proposed research (max. 3 pages),
- (5) up to 3 selected publications and working papers, including short explanations why these were selected,
- (6) a statement (max. 1 page) identifying previous and future contributions to equity, diversity and inclusion, and the candidates ability to work in culturally diverse groups, and
- (7) copies of certificates.
